

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### 2024 Benefits Open Enrollment

#### Oct. 9-23

Parkland's Open Enrollment period has begun! Starting today, Oct. 9 through 11:59 p.m. Monday, Oct. 23, you can review and adjust your benefits elections for the 2024 calendar year. This period is also an opportunity to confirm that your current mailing address and contact information is correct.

As a reminder, the in-person Benefits Fair will take place from noon – 7 p.m. on Monday, Oct. 16, and 7:30 a.m. - 5 p.m. on Tuesday, Oct. 17, in the Private Dining Room. At this event, you'll have an opportunity to speak with vendors regarding your benefits and ask questions.

Parkland will also host a booth with more information on Open Enrollment at the State Fair from 10 a.m. – 5 p.m. on Saturday, Oct. 14 (located by the African American Arts Museum and Magnolia Gardens.)

#### To complete your Open Enrollment for 2024:

- You can enroll via ParklandBenefits.org or by visiting the PeopleSoft site from the SharePoint homepage.
- Once In PeopleSoft:
  - Enter your password and User ID, which is your Parkland employee ID number.
  - After signing in, click on "Open Enrollment" icon.
- Once you log in, you can watch the Open Enrollment Video and review your contact information and address. (Step 1-3)

#### What's new to Open Enrollment in 2024:

- We're excited to announce Parkland will transition from UMR to Cigna for our medical and pharmacy plan provider. Cigna
  will provide better integration between our medical, dental, pharmacy and EAP programs, enhanced disease management/
  wellness programs and coaching.
- Premiums for the Preferred Provider Organization (PPO) and the High Deductible Health Plan (HDHP) will not increase for 2024. The Tier 1 copay for a specialist visit in the PPO will decrease from \$50 to \$30. The Tier 2 copay for a PCP visit in the PPO will increase from \$30 to \$35.

#### Key reminders for 2024 Open Enrollment

- You must take action during Open Enrollment to sell PTO.
- You can sign up for a Health Care or Dependent Care Flexible Spending Account (FSA) for 2024 during this period.
- Please note: you must enroll for the HDHP Health Plan and the Health Savings Account (HSA) to receive the Parkland contribution. You must also make a new election each year during Open Enrollment to continue participating in the HSA. Please see "Health Savings Account" tile toward the end of the enrollment page to enroll for the HSA.

### Help 'Boot the Flu' by getting your flu shot

#### Employees must get their flu shot by Nov. 15

The 2023 Employee Flu Shot Campaign will begin Monday, Oct. 2, through Wednesday, Nov. 15, to support the overall health, well-being and safety of our patients, guests and employees at Parkland. The influenza vaccine ("flu shot") is mandatory for all employees (with limited, approved exemptions)\*.

You can get your flu shot from Occupational Health Services (OHS), the Employee Health Center (EHC), at one of the flu Drive locations listed below or through a preferred provider. Employees are encouraged to attend a flu drive as early in the schedule as possible, as these events will have a maximum capacity to accommodate safety and distancing guidelines.

#### Next steps for your flu shot

- First: Complete the 2023 Influenza Vaccination Survey in <u>ReadySet</u>. If you need to reset your password, Parkland's access/org code is 1187.
- Second: Get your flu shot from OHS, the Employee Health Center or a preferred provider by 11:59 p.m. on Nov. 15; or submit a religious or medical exemption or reasonable accommodation via ReadySet to OHS by Sunday, Oct. 31.
- Third: After getting your flu shot or provide proof of compliance to OHS by 11:59 p.m. on Nov. 15, employees will receive a campus-wide flu shot sticker to apply to their ID badges.

\*Employees who do not get the flu shot by the Nov. 15 deadline (or those granted exemptions/reasonable accommodations and who do not comply with the mask requirement) will be subject to progressive discipline in accordance with <u>OTM Procedure 8000-100 Health</u> <u>Screening/ Immunizations</u>.

### **REMINDER: Proper disposal of sensitive material**

Do not toss sensitive information into blue recycle bins, as these are NOT approved for secure disposition. Any nonrecord\* material containing PHI or PII that is no longer needed and is deemed to be a transitory record should be properly disposed of to protect sensitive information using the approved methods at Parkland (locked gray shred bins, department shredders). The locked gray shred bins can also handle CDs and DVDs with cases containing sensitive information.

It is important to ensure you are not destroying official records\*\* without approval from either Records & Information Management (RIM) or Health Information Management (HIM). Refer to the approved Parkland Records Retention Schedule (RRS), <u>SYS.LEG.008</u>, and the RIM Policy, <u>SYS.LEG.007</u>. for further details.

\*Non-record/transitory – This type of information or material is generally of temporary usefulness and is not regularly filed within an official Parkland recordkeeping system or process and is generally used for a limited period of time—if at all—for the completion of an action or in the preparation of an ongoing official record.

\*\*Official record - Any content, regardless of format, created, used, received and/or retained by Parkland or any of its Workforce Members pursuant to law or in the transaction of public business.
